





PLACES TO VISIT

COW & CALF ROCKS

On the edge of Ilkley Moor, offering spectacular views of the Wharfe Valley.

EMBSAY & BOLTON ABBEY STEAM RAILWAY

Skipton. Situated just outside Skipton in Yorkshire the Embsay & Bolton Abbey Steam Railway runs 4 miles between the new award winning station at Bolton Abbey and Embsay station built in 1888. Most trains are hauled by magnificently restored steam tank engines the oldest one dating back to 1908. Trains run every Sunday throughout the year and up to 7 days a week in summer. Both stations have gift shops specialising in many Thomas the Tank engine items, a must for any young Thomas fan. They also have tea rooms, picnic areas and free parking.

BOLTON ABBEY ESTATE

Bolton Abbey, Skipton. Bolton Abbey Estate covers 30,000 acres of beautiful countryside in the Yorkshire Dales. There are medieval buildings to explore and 80 miles of moorland, woodland and riverside footpaths. This beautiful, well kept country Estate is open to the public. There are picnic areas, tearooms, restaurants and gift shops.

DARWIN GARDENS

Darwin Gardens Millenium Green is situated only a few minutes' walk from Ilkley town centre. Explore the area around the Green and enjoy the beautiful views of Ilkley Moor that surrounds the location. Picnic tables and seats are provided and much of the site is accessible to the disabled/less-able visitor.

Situated alongside the River Wharfe in Ilkley with plenty of green space and

benches. The riverside park is very popular with locals and visitors attracting families from all over West Yorkshire who visit to relax, walk, play and enjoy the surroundings.

ILKLEY TOY MUSEUM

The many exhibits feature dolls, dolls houses, teddy bears, tinplate toys, lead figures and a selection of games together with wooden and paper toys. Dating from 350BC to the present day the exhibits include a 1940s working model fairground

THE MANOR HOUSE

The Manor House was described by Alan Titchmarsh, patron of the Trust, as 'the jewel in Ilkley's crown'. The vision for this lively space is to develop a creative heritage, arts, learning and leisure centre based round the Manor House, its cottages and its wonderful courtyard. The aim is to capitalize on the historic appeal of the Grade 1 listed building and the unique location between the town and the Riverside Gardens, adjacent to All Saints Church and the Roman Fort to create a unified site, working alongside the church, with heritage exhibitions that will engage the arts, culture and leisure sectors. The cottages will be used by creative industries as studio spaces and start-up business lets to create an enterprising unique development in Ilkley.

WHITE WELLS AT WHITE WELLS SPA COTTAGE

There has been bathing at White Wells since 1703 when there was a bath to the rear of the premises. This was replaced in 1791 by two baths, one of which is on display today. Although the water has no significant mineral content it is the coldness of the water which stimulates the circulation
